In 1987 Edith Cowan University opened the Joondalup Campus to students and at that stage there was no off campus residential housing close to the university. It was difficult for students to find suitable accommodation and it was a further nine years (1996) before the first residential land close to the university was released for sale.

With the first release of land Brooke Stone recognized the huge opportunity to provide relatively inexpensive share accommodation to allow different student cultural groups to live together in harmony but able to pursue their individual religions and cuisine.

By 2002 Brooke Stone, acting as trustee

for various syndicates, had built 37 houses to accommodate students and established themselves as the foremost Student Accommodation Agency in the Northern Suburbs. Many owners were requesting Brooke Stone to either manage or sell their property and by 2006 Brooke Stone were accommodating over 400 overseas students. Some of these houses return to their owners between \$700 and \$1000 per week.
